Please read all information and instructions before completing and submitting your application.

Eligibility Criteria

To qualify for admission to the CCQ Honors Program, you must:

- have a minimum GPA of 3.5
- maintain a clean disciplinary record

Admission Requirements

Please submit all required documents by email to Nate Schell, Lead Learning Engagement Faculty, Center for Learning and Civic Engagement, – clce@ccq.edu.qa

- A complete Honors Program application and copies of all requested documents
- Submit an essay on an assigned topic in English or Arabic (see topic list on p.4)
- Two letters of recommendation from college faculty
- Copy of CCQ transcript

Official Test Scores and Transcripts: (Submit to Nate Schell at above address)

Official high school transcripts and CCQ transcripts

Honors Program Acceptance Criteria

Students who meet the criteria listed above may submit an Honors Program application. A combination of grades, test scores, recommendations, essay on an assigned topic, and an entrance interview will be used to determine acceptance into the Honors Program.

Maintenance Requirements

- Maintain a 3.5 GPA
- Be a currently enrolled student at CCO
- May not withdraw from classes without consultation with Honors Program director
- Sign and maintain the Honors College Code of Behavior and Academic Honesty Policy

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The Honors Program - Student Membership Contract Code of Behavior and Academic Honesty Policy

As a member of the Honors Program, I understand the following rules and regulations pertaining to obtaining and maintaining membership in the program, and agree to abide by them. I understand that failure to meet the expectations of the following guidelines will result in my initial application being rejected, or being expelled from the program.

- 1. I must have a college-level GPA of 3.5 or higher to be admitted to the program, and must maintain this GPA in order to remain in the program.
- 2. I must be a currently-enrolled student at CCQ in order to remain in the program. If I leave CCQ for a period of one semester or longer and resume my studies at CCQ at a later date, I must reapply for admission to the program.
- 3. I must have no disciplinary issues on my record at CCQ. I understand that this would prevent me from entering the program, or cause my expulsion from the program.
- 4. I understand that any substantiated allegations of academic dishonesty will result in my expulsion from the program, and that I will not be allowed to re-apply.
- 5. I understand that, as a member of the Honors Program, I represent the program and everything that it stands for. I will strive to be a model for other students to emulate; in and outside of the classroom.
- 6. I understand that any Honors classes I take will only count for Honors credit if I receive a grade of "B" or higher. Any grade lower than a "B" will be coded for a standard course.
- 7. I understand that I may not withdraw from an Honors class, or switch a contracted Honors course back to the standard course designation, without prior approval of the program Director.
